

ORDINANCE NO. 19-89

ORDINANCE REQUIRING DISPLAY OF ADDRESS STREET NUMBERS
ON BUILDINGS IN THE VILLAGE OF WESTON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON,
COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: Every owner of any residential, commercial or
industrial building in The Village of Weston shall display the
address street number on the front of said building.

SECTION 2: Every number shall be legible and fixed in a
conspicuous location on the front of the building in numbers
of at least three (3) inches in height but not more than six (6)
inches in height, and visible from the public right-of-way.

SECTION 3: All such numbers shall be installed not later than
sixty (60) days after the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: Any person, firm or corporation who violates this
ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$5.00 or
more than \$200.00 for such offense. Each twenty-four (24) hour
period that any violation of this ordinance continues to exist
shall constitute and be a separate offense under the terms hereof.

SECTION 5: The Clerk of The Village of Weston shall have this
ordinance made a part of the Codified Ordinances of The Village
of Weston.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force
and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
