Ordinance No. 2017-25 Passed December 18, 2017

ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, OHIO FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2018 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2018; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

**Section 1:** That to provide for the current expenses and expenditures of the Village of Weston, Ohio through the first quarter of 2018, the following amounts shall be appropriated in each fund (see attached for more detailed breakdown by program code):
