

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE OPWC FUND (4903); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Weston, Ohio is hereby authorized to transfer **\$41,436.19** from the General Fund to the OPWC (Center Street) Fund. This will cover the Village's local share portion of the project cost (amount in excess of grant funds).

Section 2: That the council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with acceptable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the ORC.

Section 3: That this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public welfare and safety, due to the need to provide timely payment for the above named project, and therefore, shall go into immediate effect upon passage.
