

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING COMPENSATION FOR APPOINTED FISCAL OFFICER; REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Village of Weston fiscal officer, Lisa Heft, previously appointed, has resigned her position effective January 26, 2017; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that Cheryl Halter had the qualifications to fill the position of fiscal officer; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor of the Village of Weston has appointed Cheryl Halter as fiscal officer for the Village Weston according to Ohio Revised Code Section 733.262(D); and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 733.262(D) requires that said appointment be approved by a majority of council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, COUNTY OF WOOD AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That effective to May 8, 2018, the Village Fiscal Officer shall be compensated at a rate of \$25.50/hour, receiving regular reviews no less than once per year, as determined by the Mayor with the advice and consent of council.

Section 2: That said Village Fiscal Officer shall perform the duties of said office according to Ohio Revised Code Section 733.262, including but not limited to maintaining all financial obligations of the Village; and any and all other duties outlined in a job description to be assembled and documented with the Fiscal Officer, Mayor, and Council.

Section 3: That any existing residency requirements are hereby waived.

Section 4: That Ordinance 2017-3 and all other ordinances inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 5: That the council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with acceptable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6: That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the Village to meet its financial obligations in a timely manner, and therefore shall go into immediate effect upon passage.
