

ORDINANCE TO AMEND 2018 APPROPRIATIONS (ORDINANCE 2018-4) FOR PURCHASE OF MARCS RADIOS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, STATE OF OHIO DURING THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2018 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2018 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
