

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO ADOPTING THE
FEDERALLY APPROVED WOOD COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS the Weston Village Council recognize the threat that natural, human-caused,
and technological hazards pose to people and property within Wood County; and

WHEREAS Wood County has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as
WOOD COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN of August 24, 2018 in accordance with the
Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS the WOOD COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN identifies mitigation goals
and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Wood County from the
impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Weston Village Council demonstrates their commitment to
the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the WOOD COUNTY HAZARD
MITIGATION PLAN of August 24, 2018.

WHEREAS the plan has been approved by the Federal Emergency Management
Agency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON,
WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1: Council, adopting the determinations recited above, hereby adopt the WOOD
COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

Section 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this council
concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were done in an Open Meeting of
Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of it's committees that resulted in such
formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements,
including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: That this resolution shall be effective from and after it's passage at the earliest
period allowed by law.
