

ORDINANCE # _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RATE SCHEDULE FOR WESTON EMS SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the Village of Weston is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

Whereas, the Village of Weston has powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3, including the power to assess and collect fees for Emergency Medical Services, and

Whereas, the Finance Committee of the Council has recommended increasing the EMS rates as a result of increased costs incurred for such; and

Whereas, the Council of the Village of Weston concurs in the said increases, and as a result, enacts this Ordinance according to law;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Weston, Wood County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The current EMS rates, as established by this Council, Ordinance 2014-9, are as follows:

Section 2: The new EMS rates, effective February 1, 2019, are as follows:

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the consideration and passage of this measure were taken in meetings open to the public, and that all deliberations of this Council and any committees were held at meetings open to the public in accordance with R.C. 121.22

Section 4: This Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents, for the reason that immediate implementation of the proposed rate changes are essential to maintaining EMS services. Without such changes the fiscal stability of the service is at risk.
