VILLAGE OF WESTON, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2024-22

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR WESTON EMS PERSONNEL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston has powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston recognizes the importance of volunteer Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel in safeguarding public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Village values the dedication, training, and time commitment of its EMS volunteers and seeks to compensate them fairly for their services to the community; and

WHEREAS, providing compensation for volunteer EMS personnel will promote the recruitment and retention of qualified volunteers, thereby enhancing the quality and reliability of emergency medical services within the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Weston, Wood County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The EMS Chief of the Village of Weston, Ohio shall be paid the annual sum of \$3,744.00, payable in twelve (12) equal installments of \$312.00.

SECTION 2: The EMS Assistant Chief of the Village of Weston, Ohio shall be paid the annual sum of \$3,204.00, payable in twelve (12) equal installments of \$267.00.

SECTION 3: The EMS Captain of the Village of Weston, Ohio shall be paid the annual sum of \$1,800.00, payable in twelve (12) equal installments of \$150.00.

SECTION 4: The EMS Clerk of the Village of Weston, Ohio shall be paid the annual sum of \$5,268.00, payable in twelve (12) equal installments of \$439.00.

SECTION 5: All volunteer personnel with Weston EMS will receive an honorarium per ambulance run, defined as any time the ambulance departs the station with an "enroute" status reported to the county and leaves the property. If total honorarium payment for an ambulance run exceeds \$235, the honorarium payments shall be prorated among all participating volunteers. Payment will only be provided to those either actively transporting with the ambulance or scheduled for duty during the run. Payments will be disbursed monthly.

1) Honorarium Compensation rates are as follows:

- a) Medic level at \$100
- b) Advanced level at \$85
- c) Basic level at \$50.

SECTION 6: This ordinance and the rates established herein shall be effective January 1, 2025.

SECTION 7: All ordinances, policies, provisions, and conditions amended hereby or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION 8: This measure is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, welfare and best interests of the Village and its residents for the reason that maintaining a consistent level of talented first responders is crucial to protecting the residents of the village. There are an insufficient number of regularly scheduled meetings to read this measure three times.

SECTION 9: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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


